KIA ORA AOTEAROA

As the air cools and the pace softens, Rotorua shifts into the seasons made for slowing down. These are experiences that don't compete for your attention; they reward it.

COZY STAYS YOU'LL WANT TO CHECK INTO

Autumn and winter are the seasons that invite you to stay in. To slow down, light the fire and let the outside world soften around you.





In Rotorua, it's the time of year when accommodation becomes more than just a place to sleep, it feels as memorable as the trip itself.

Rotorua's cooler months reveal a different kind of stay – one where character, comfort and setting become part of the experience itself. Places designed for switching off and spending quality time together – couples' getaways, long weekends with friends, and escapes that feel easy yet memorable.

WHEN THE SEASON DOES THE STYLING

At places like *Jack's Hut* and *Wildberry Cottage*, autumn and winter bring a sense of retreat – warm interiors paired with forest views, crisp mornings and evenings that naturally slow the pace. These are stays that encourage early nights, slow starts and long conversations.

DESIGNED FOR CONNECTION

For those travelling with friends or planning a long weekend away, accommodation like *The Red Barn* and *Toka Ridge* offer space to gather without feeling crowded. Think shared meals, open living areas and landscapes that invite you to step outside, then come back in again. Cooler temperatures make these moments even better – fires lit, doors open just enough, the outside world close but not demanding.

IMMERSED IN NATURE, WITHOUT THE RUSH

Rotorua's stays are also about connection to the land. *Kokako Retreat* and *Pamū PurePod* place you directly in the landscape, where the changing season becomes part of the experience. From misty mornings to golden afternoons, these stays allow you to witness the seasons unfolding in real time – quietly, gently and without distraction.

This is accommodation for manuhiri (visitors) who value stillness as much as scenery, and comfort as much as design. Rotorua doesn't ask you to do more. It invites you to stay longer, settle in and enjoy the feeling of being exactly where you are meant to be.

WARM PLATES, LONG CHATS

There's something about the cooler months that gives you permission to stay a little longer. Another coffee. One more shared plate. A conversation that drifts from plans to memories without anyone checking the time.

As the air cools and mornings slow, brunch becomes less about refuelling and more about reconnecting – with the people across the table and the moment you're in.

These are the seasons for meals that stretch out, where you arrive late morning and leave when the light has shifted. You'll find yourself choosing places that make lingering feel natural, not rushed. Spots where the food arrives warm and comforting, the atmosphere relaxed, and the only thing on the agenda is being present.

At *Eastwood*, that feeling starts as soon as you sit down. The menu leans into flavour without fuss – the kind of food that's satisfying but still leaves room for conversation. You'll notice how tables fill slowly, plates are shared and no one seems in a hurry to leave. It's an easy place to settle in, especially when cooler days call for something hearty and familiar.

Further out, *Okere Falls Store* capture brunch at its most laid-back. You'll feel it in the way people arrive fresh from a walk or a drive, jackets slung over chairs, dogs curled at feet. Generous portions, bold flavours and the kind of dishes that spark conversation as soon as they hit the table. It's the sort of place where you'll plan to stop briefly and end up staying well past lunch.

Mr Wolf brings its own kind of energy – relaxed and welcoming, with the conservatory seating catching the daylight. It's a spot where brunch feels social, easy, familiar and perfect for catchups.

Hello Stranger Café on Hinemoa Street adds another easy option that invites you to stay awhile. Sitting cosy inside or rugged up outside at the picnic tables, you'll feel the season shift around you – cool air, warm cups, and that steady hum of the city moving past at just the right pace. It's the kind of spot where brunch spills into late morning without effort, where you can stretch out in the sun, share something sweet or savoury, and let conversations wander without interruption. Simple, social and relaxed, it's made for long chats that don't need an end time.

When comfort is calling in the evening, *Spa City Noodle* delivers it in bowl form. There's something grounding about wrapping your hands around a warm bowl as the season turns. You'll notice how quickly time slips by when you're seated together, steam rising, conversations unfolding naturally between mouthfuls. It's unfussy, welcoming and perfect for group catch-ups that don't need a special occasion.

What ties these places together isn't just the food – it's the pace. Gatherings feel easier when no one is rushing off to the next thing. You'll find yourself talking longer, laughing louder and ordering that extra dish simply because it feels right.

As days shorten and routines shift inward, brunch becomes a way to hold onto connection. These are the kinds of places where memories are made quietly – across shared plates, long chats, and the understanding that there's nowhere else you need to be.



BIKE & BITE: PEDAL THE TRAILS, SAVOUR THE FLAVOURS



The cooler months are when Rotorua riding hits its sweet spot. Crisp air, quieter trails and that unmistakable hero dirt under your tyres - grippy, fast and forgiving.

These are the seasons when the ride feels smoother, every corner flows better and the reward at the end tastes even better.

There's a reason why autumn and winter are considered the best times to ride in Rotorua. As summer dust settles, the trails firm up into that gold-standard riding surface...Hero Dirt. You'll feel it immediately – confident climbs, controlled descents and a rhythm that makes you want to keep going just a little longer.

The *Whakarewarewa Forest* offers extensive trails that suit every kind of rider, whether you're out for a quick spin or committing to a full morning in the trees. Cooler temperatures make longer rides more comfortable, with less heat build-up and more energy left in the tank. Light filters through the leaves, the forest feels calmer and riding becomes as much about the environment as the movement.

Not every ride has to be deep in the forest. Rotorua is also ideal for softer, slower adventures on two wheels. Cruising through town by bike becomes part of the experience – lakeside paths, quiet streets and easy rides that let you take Rotorua in at street level. It's a way to keep moving without pushing, perfect for recovery days or casual outings that still feel rewarding.

When it's time to refuel, Rotorua delivers without overcomplicating things. Post-ride hunger is real and comfort comes first. *Patrick's Pies* offers a fast, satisfying stop that feels earned after time on the bike. *The Secret Spot Hot Tubs'* food truck adds another easy option – relaxed, outdoors and well-suited to tired legs that don't want to wander far.

For something more substantial, *Eastwood* delivers with wood-fired pizzas that hit the balance between indulgent and familiar. It's the kind of meal that restores energy without stealing momentum from the rest of the day. Across the forest, *Trail Kitchen* rewards riders who push a little deeper, offering a proper sit-down meal that feels like the natural next step after a solid ride.

The final reward comes in warm water. Autumn and winter make soaking especially satisfying – cool air above, heat below, muscles easing back into place. Rotorua's hot pools are the perfect counterpoint to a day on the bike, whether you're soaking beneath trees or alongside the lake.

Riding in Rotorua isn't just better – it's balanced. Ride hard or ride easy. Forest or town. Food that comforts and water that restores. These are the seasons when it all comes together.

HELL'S GATE GEOTHERMAL RESERVE & MUD SPA

As winter approaches, witness a land born of myth and legend, where Rūaumoko heats the Earth from a world below, boiling mud and billowing steam into the air. Journey through native bush into an active geothermal landscape, bathe in mud and sulphur pools, and revitalise the mind, body and soul.

UNCOVER THE WONDERS OF GEOTHERMAL

Located on the outskirts of Rotorua lies the awe-inspiring geothermal reserve best known today as Hell's Gate.

Steeped in myth and legend, this landscape has much to discover. Walking through the geothermal reserve, it is hard to ignore the power of Rūaumoko (the god of volcanoes) as steam billows to the sky and the earth boils and bubbles around you. Native flora, teeming with bird life, holds hidden wonders before opening into an array of different geothermal features waiting to be discovered around every corner. From the largest hot waterfall in the Southern Hemisphere to mud volcanoes and erupting waters, you'll find it here.





Be inspired by joining one of our guided tours, offering insights into the history, cultural and scientific significance of the area. These depart daily at 10:30am and 2:30pm, subject to availability.

After your geothermal walk join us in our interactive Carving House, where our talented carvers will not only demonstrate their artistry but also guide you in creating your own taonga (treasure) to take home.

Hell's Gate doesn't just entertain and educate, it soothes too. A treasured place of healing and revitalization for Māori for more than 500 years, we are now home to New Zealand's only geothermal mud bath experience. Our geothermal mud is unique to this area, and renowned for its therapeutic benefits and rejuvenating properties.

Begin your journey by immersing yourself in geothermal pools as you lather yourself head to toe in silky, smooth, geothermal mud. Relax as nature nurtures the body and mind, opening the pores and exfoliating, detoxifying and nourishing the skin, leaving it feeling rejuvenated and fresh.

Following this indulgent experience, take in the truly unique geothermal landscape of Hell's Gate as you soak in nutrient-rich sulphur spas.

Unwind to the sound of waterfalls and native bird or revitalize the body and take the plunge in the cold pool. Promoting relaxation, relieving aching muscles and offering relief for various skin ailments, the healing waters of Tikitere have been sought out for centuries.

ESCAPE THE COLD FOR WINTER WELLNESS

In the cold of winter Hell's Gate truly comes alive. Our bubbling pools of acidic water, sulphurous springs and steaming fumaroles are only made more dramatic as they billow into the cold air. Perched above the stunning Te Whakarewarewa geothermal valley, Pātaka Kai Restaurant & Bar offers a fusion of Māori-inspired cuisine and breathtaking natural beauty.

Sunday Brunch is a locals favourite and is exclusively offered Easter weekend (3 – 5 April) and then from 12 April – 27 September every Sunday. The menu includes freshly baked breakfast pastries, twice-cooked sticky glazed pork ribs, dumplings, hot smoked king salmon, chef's seafood boil and more. MĀRAMA RELAUNCH THIS WINTER

After its first winter launch with rave reviews, Mārama Geyser Night Trail is taking a break from April, to then re-launch at the end of June in time for Matariki 2026 and beyond. Expect amplified lighting, new Māori soundscapes, more artwork and storytelling.

Meander past glowing artworks and down the valley through light, sound and shadow. Follow the luminous forest trail echoing with waiata of the valley, past bubbling mud pools, steam, and the flowing waters of Puarenga Stream, with dynamic laser projections transforming the darkness. Pause to take it all in while warming up on our geothermal hot rock terrace. At Pikirangi Village lookout you'll see enchanting views across the valley and experience a starry night immersion.

Perfect for all ages, Mārama offers a moment of stillness, wonder, and connection – to the whenua, to te ao Māori, and to each other.

TE RĀ GUIDED TOUR EXPERIENCE

Immerse yourself in a world of geysers, bubbling mud pools, and pristine native forest, all shared through our tours with sixth and seventh generation guides.

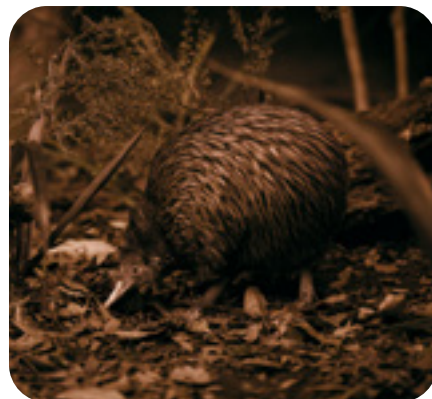
Encounter the Southern Hemisphere's largest natural geyser, Pōhutu, which naturally erupts skyward sometimes reaching heights of 30 metres (100 feet) over 17 times a day. This is New Zealand's most active geyser and is a sight to behold. Pōhutu means 'constant splashing' in te reo Māori.

At Te Puia, not only will you witness the earth's raw power, but you'll also delve into the heart of Māori culture at the New Zealand Māori Arts and Crafts Institute. This place has a significant 100-year legacy. Watch skilled wood, stone and bone carvers and weavers demonstrate their expertise.

You can also check out the cutting-edge Kiwi Conservation Centre, a haven dedicated to New Zealand's national treasure: the native Kiwi bird.

You can take the experience to another level by seeing a cultural performance – these happen daily inside a traditionally carved meeting house (wharenui).

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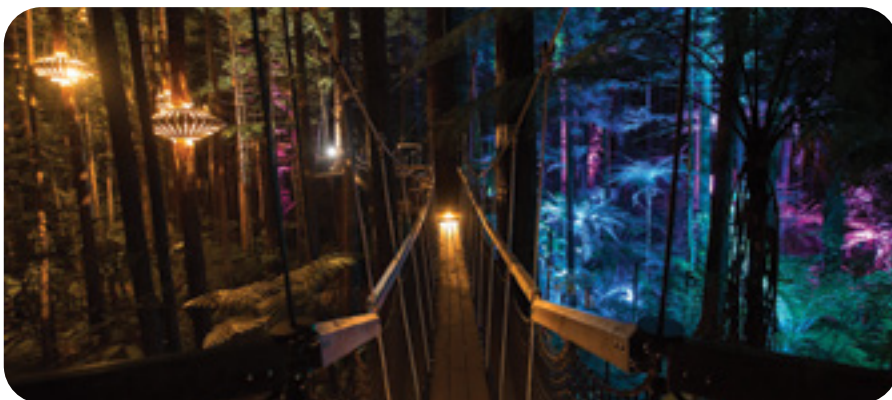
GUARDIANS OF THE FOREST

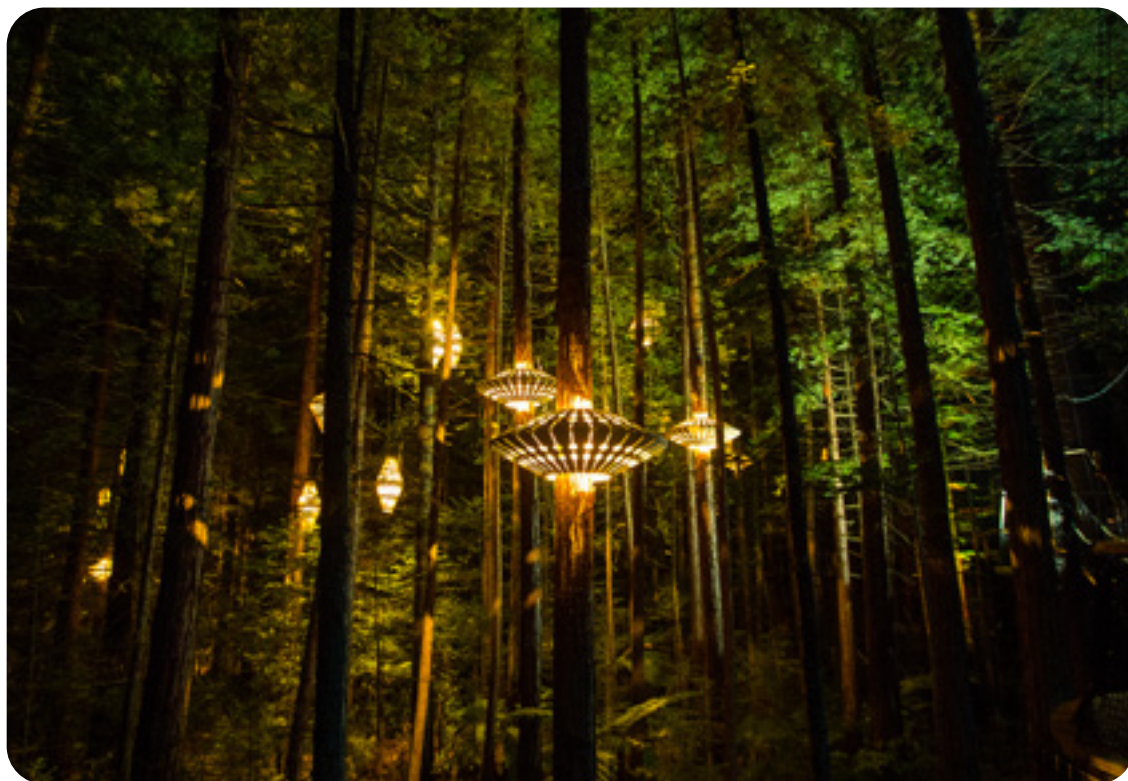

REDWOODS TREEWALK

Suspended high within the forest canopy, the award-winning Redwoods Treewalk has become one of Rotorua's most iconic attractions. This 700-metre walkway features 28 suspension bridges and viewing platforms, offering a gentle, peaceful way to explore the 125-year-old Redwood grove and view the NZ silver ferns from above.





These towering trees grow up to ten times faster than California where the seeds originated in the 1800s, creating a unique environment rich in flora, fauna, and quiet wonder. Perfect for couples, families, and travellers wanting a memorable nature experience, Treewalk blends thoughtful design with the beauty of Rotorua's most beloved forest.

REDWOODS NIGHTLIGHTS

As evening settles over Rotorua, the forest transforms into something truly extraordinary. Redwoods Nightlights now features over 90 Trubridge lanterns, turning the forest into a glowing, dreamlike world. Each handcrafted lantern casts intricate patterns of light, creating an atmosphere that feels both enchanting and unmistakably New Zealand. Whether it's a clear night or a misty one, the forest comes alive in a way that captivates visitors of every age. It's a favourite for locals and a must-see for international travellers wanting a magical after-dark experience.

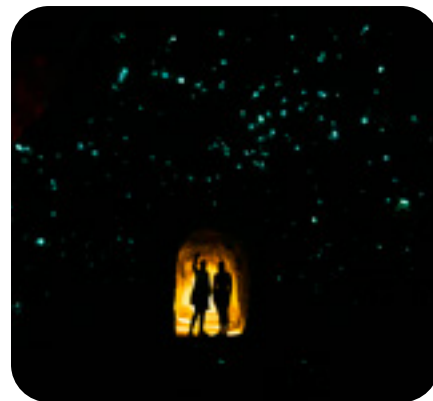
REDWOODS GLOWWORMS

Redwoods Glowworms offers an up-close look at one of nature's most captivating light displays. The most convenient and accessible glowworm experience in New Zealand, the experience takes around 15 minutes and

is only a \$15 adult or \$7.50 child upgrade to your Treewalk price. Redwoods Glowworms experience sits inside a specially designed world first Glowworm grotto, where 1000's of real glowworms create a miniature starry sky. Your phone camera is allowed (no flash) and will capture these amazing insects, just centimeters away. These tiny creatures glow to attract their prey, dangling delicate silk threads that shimmer in the dark – a fairytale scene found only in Aotearoa, New Zealand. Open daily from 9.30 to late. REDWOODS ALTITUDE

For those craving a little more adventure, Redwoods Altitude takes exploration to new heights – literally. This fully guided experience reaches up to 30 meters above the forest floor and offers an Indiana Jones-style journey through the treetops. With 25 themed swing bridges and three zip lines, it's an active, hands-on way to see the Redwoods from a whole new perspective. Small group departures run daily, and the 2.5-hour experience feels like stepping into the action-packed version of Treewalk. Just five minutes from Rotorua's CBD, it's an unforgettable treetop adventure for thrill-seekers and nature lovers alike. Bookings are essential.

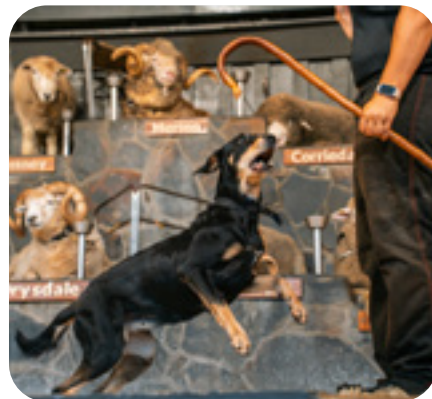


AGRODOME A WORLD OF FUN ON THE FARM!

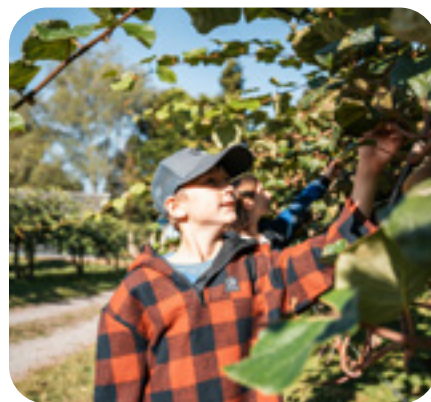


a world away from city life. Don't forget your camera to capture that epic scenic shot looking out toward Lake Rotorua and Mokoia Island!

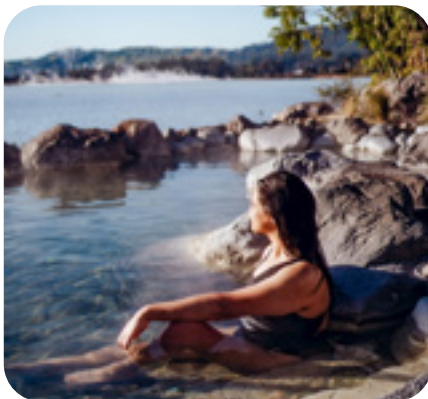
DISCOVER ROTORUA'S MOST ICONIC SOAK

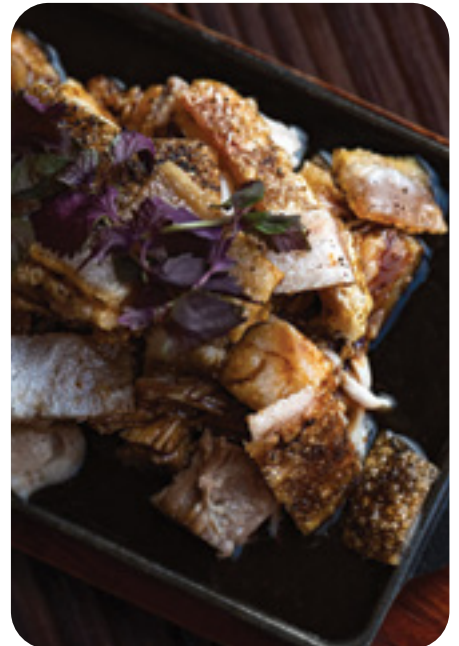
Te Pā Tū offers 3.5-hour evening events that change with each season of the maramataka, the Māori lunar calendar.

Throughout winter, Tū Te Ihi marks promise heralded by the arrival of the Matariki star cluster which high and bright in winter skies, signalling the new lunar year – we share the energy and passion of this celebration.

Across summer, Tū Te Rā celebrates an abundant harvest, and we explore concepts, rituals, and stories of ancient Māori warfare and peace.

Cultural knowledge unique to each season is shared from the outset – rituals, songs, and stories continue across the night. From the beginning too, we share local, seasonal kai (food), plentiful and delicious. Kai horotai (indigenous canapes) are followed by a torch lit walk to a lavish 3-course fusion feast.

Our world-famous traditional hāngi shares the table with other seasonal delicacies.



Meats, foraged plants, seafood, local produce are prepared in a fusion of cooking techniques, Māori and global. All our kai draws purpose and inspiration from Māori flavours, healing properties, history, heroes.
